

# Rigby's Farmhouse Wine List

## White Wines

- 1. Sauvignon Blanc, Central Monte, Chile** £17.00  
With fresh lime and lemon on the nose, forming the aromatic backdrop; and more citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of grapefruit, and mouthwatering acidity. An excellent value dry white.
- 2. Pinot Grigio, Sereno, Italy** £17.00  
This delicious wine has a light citrus aroma which leads to a mixture of juicy fruits and just a hint of vanilla on the palate.
- 3. Riesling, Piesporter Michelsberg Schmitt Sohne Qba, Germany** £17.00  
A medium white wine, produced from the steep slate soils of the Mosel valley, this wine is well balanced with complex grape aromas and a delicate citrus finish.
- 4. Chardonnay, Down Under Chardonnay, Australia** £17.00  
This Chardonnay displays all the classic characteristic of zesty lemon and apple aromas. The flavours of white peach and pear burst on the palate. A truly delightful wine that can be enjoyed anytime.
- 5. White Rioja, Marques del Atrio, Spain** £20.00  
Fresh, fruity hints, tropical fruit aromas with elegant herbaceous overtones. Good intense white with a clean and well-balanced feel. Very fresh with a fruity, intense, sweet and long aftertaste.
- 6. Sauvignon Blanc, Turtle Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand** £21.00  
This wine is fresh and vibrant with passion fruit, classic gooseberry and some melon characters. It has a balanced richness of fruit with a floral note through the palate, with intense depth and a crisp finish.
- 7. Chablis, Victor Berard, Burgundy, France** £25.00  
Bone dry, lively and fresh with clean citrus aromas. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean with lots of those classic steely flint mineral qualities that make a great Chablis wine.
- 8. Sauternes, Chateau Les Mingets, Bordeaux, France (1/2 Bottle)** £25.00  
A concentrated, luscious sweet dessert wine showing intense flavours of caramelized fruits, pear, melon and almond, rounded and balanced by good acidity.

## Rosé Wines

- 9. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Cramele Recas, Romania** £17.00  
This dry style of rosé wine shows why rose is so popular. Lively raspberry and floral aromas with fresh strawberry and apple notes on the palate.
- 10. Zinfandel Rosé, Healy & Gray, California, USA** £17.00  
A medium dry rosé with a bright salmon pink colour and fresh nose of raspberry and strawberry.

## Red Wines (please note where vintages are quoted these may change)

11. **Merlot, Luna Azul, Chile** £17.00  
This attractive Merlot displays varietal aromas of cassis and liquorice. The palate is fleshy and mouth filling with flavours of plum, sweet spice and a hint of chocolate. with soft mature tannins and a rounded easy style that is both subtle and elegant
12. **Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Monte, Chile** £17.00  
Full bodied and velvety this wine is bursting with rich red fruits and a hint of vanilla. A real joy to drink an a superb wine to enjoy with a steak and red meats.
13. **Shiraz, Jarrah Wood, Australia** £17.00  
A medium weight red, this classic Australian Shiraz is packed with ripe cherry and raspberry flavours with a pepper spice finish.
14. **Pinot Noir, Cramele Recas, Romania** £20.00  
A lighter weight red, with soft complex aromas of black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. A lighter medium bodied red wine with dried fruit notes and combined with fresh red berries and sweet spice on the palate. Seriously easy drinking!
15. **Malbec, Illusion, Bonarda, Argentina** £20.00  
Deep and intense red-violet colour, with aromas of red fruits, plums, black cherries and forest berries. Fresh and full, with sweet, juicy ample tannins and a very elegant finish.
16. **Côtes du Rhône, Victor Berard, 2016, France** £22.00  
Warm spicy wine that has a soft peppery taste coming from the Grenache and Syrah varietals. Medium to full bodied, high acidity with black currants on the palate, soft and silky tannins contribute to a long and rounded finish.
17. **Claret, Chateau Le Gardera, Bordeaux Superieur, 2010 , France** £25.00  
This fantastic Gonfrier family property is among the best of the appellation, producing a firm rich wine from 60% Merlot and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. Le Gardera has fine tannins, full of soft berry fruits with a use of subtle oak aging and an excellent balance.
18. **Rioja, Fincas de Azabache Gran Reserva, 2007, Spain** £35.00  
This excellent classic and savoury Gran Reserva Rioja is selected from the best vineyards from an exceptional year. The blend includes 70% Tempranillo, 20% Garnacha and 10% Graciano, which has been softened by three years in oak and three more in bottle before release. Superb with lamb.

## Champagne & Sparkling Wines

19. **Asti Martini DOCG, Torino, Italy** £20.00  
The old favourite made with Muscato Bianco grapes gives a classic balance between lightness and sweetness with delicate flavours of pear, green apple and peach.
20. **Prosecco, Serenello Extra Dry, Italy** £20.00  
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, the delicious aromas of apple and pear melt into a smooth and fresh wine on the palate.
21. **Champagne, Cuperley Brut NV, France** £35.00  
One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, dating back to 1845 and remains today within the original family. This Champagne has delicious fresh fruit flavours with richness and complexity.

## White Wines

### **Sauvignon Blanc, Chile**

**Dry**

With fresh lime and lemon on the nose, forming the aromatic backdrop; and more citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of grapefruit, and mouthwatering acidity. An excellent dry white.

### **Pinot Grigio, Italy**

**Off Dry & Easy Drinking**

The pale hue of the wine gives way to hints of perfume, vanilla and citrus, as well as the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine.

### **Riesling, Piesporter, Mosel, Germany**

**Medium**

A crisp fruity and refreshing medium Riesling white wine from the mineral rich slate soils of the Mosel Valley.

## Rosé Wines

### **Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy**

**Dry**

This wine shows why rose is so popular. A light dry blush wine, beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes.

### **Zinfandel Rosé, California, USA**

**Medium Dry**

Bright coral in colour, with a delicious sweetness, offset by a tangy acidity. The intense cherry and raspberry fruit burst enthusiastically onto the palate.

## Red Wines

### **Merlot, Chile**

**Light to Medium Easy Drinking**

Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, the palate has a thick and jammy feel, with soft mature tannins and a rounded easy style that is both subtle and elegant.

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile**

**Full Bodied**

Deep red in colour. Rich mulberry, plum and cassis fruit aromas with flavours of dark berries and plums, are enhanced by delicate floral hints. A Superb wine with steak and red meats.

### **Shiraz, Australia**

**Medium & Spicy**

A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.
