

Rigby's Farmhouse Wine List

White Wines

1. **Sauvignon Blanc, Vina Carrasco, Chile** £16.00
With fresh lime and lemon on the nose, forming the aromatic backdrop; and more citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple, and mouthwatering acidity. An excellent value dry white.
2. **Pinot Grigio, Malandrino, Italy** £16.00
The pale hue of the wine gives way to hints of perfume, pears, stone fruit and lime, as well as the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine.
3. **Riesling, Slate Hill, Dr Loosen, Germany** £18.00
A medium white wine, offering a fresh aromatic bouquet followed by ripe fruit flavours and an attractive sweetness, with good balancing acidity.
4. **Chardonnay, Five Foot Track, Australia** £17.00
Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel.
5. **Chenin Blanc, Bantry Bay, South Africa** £17.00
An aromatic dry white wine with hints of tropical and citrus fruit on the nose and palate.
6. **Vinho Verde, Quinta de Azevedo, Portugal** £18.00
Complex aromas of white and tropical fruits, lemons and white flowers. A lively and stimulating wine, with good acidity and well balanced, hints of spritz and bubble, with a concentrated and fresh finish.
7. **Moscatel, Late Harvest Vistamar, Limari Valley, Chile** (1/2 Bottle) £18.00
A straw yellow golden colour, with the grapes giving characteristic aromas of peaches and apricots with a subtle hint of wild flowers. With a full rich grape flavour giving way to figs, this wine is sweet but with moderate acidity, it offers a long and persistent finish.
8. **Sauvignon Blanc Fernlands Marlborough New Zealand** £20.00
Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettle herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.
9. **Chablis, La Cape de St.Martin, Burgundy, France** £25.00
Dry, lively and fresh with clean citrus aromas. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean with plenty of those classic mineral qualities that make a great Chablis wine.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

10. **Cava Calamino, Spain** £18.00
Fresh and harmonious, plenty of apple and toast flavours, yet intensely dry and mouth-watering.
11. **Asti Martini DOCG, Torino, Italy** £18.00
The old favourite made with Muscato Bianco grapes gives a classic balance between lightness and sweetness with delicate flavours of pear, green apple and peach.
12. **Prosecco, Corte Alta, Italy** £19.00
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.
13. **Champagne, J de Telmont Grande Réserve NV, France** £35.00
One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.

Rosé Wines

14. **Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy** £16.00
This wine shows why rose is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes.
15. **Blushmore Zinfandel Rosé, Italy** £17.00
Bright coral in colour, with a delicious sweetness, offset by a tangy acidity. The intense cherry and raspberry fruit burst enthusiastically onto the palate, with a fine natural spritz.
16. **Mont Rosé Cuvée, Rosato Vino Spumante, Dry, Cantina Sociale Montelliana, Italy** £20.00
A salmon pink colour with a light aromatic body and fine bubbles, this dry sparkling wine carries lots of fresh apricot and apple flavours with a revitalising strawberry finish .

Red Wines

17. **Merlot, Vina Carrasco, Chile** £16.00
Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a thick and jammy feel, with soft mature tannins and a rounded easy drinking medium style red.
18. **Cabernet Sauvignon, Robertson Estate, South Africa** £17.00
Deep red in colour. Rich mulberry, plum and cassis fruit aromas with flavours of dark berries and plums, are enhanced by soft, rounded tannins and a fruit-driven finish. Superb with steak and red meats.
19. **Shiraz, Five Foot Track, Australia** £18.00
A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.
20. **Chianti, Casale Di Valle, Italy** £19.00
Bright ruby red in colour, with density and persistent legs. Aromas of cherry and fresh red fruits mingle with spicy pepper notes. Lively and supple on the palate, with fine, rounded tannins.
21. **Rioja, Marques De Laia, Crianza 2013, Spain** £20.00
Red cherry colour of medium intensity with violet hues. Direct and fresh nose. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. In mouth soft but with body and structure. A very pleasant entry on the palate and a good finish.
22. **Pinot Noir, Claro, Chile** £20.00
A richly fruity Pinot Noir, full of ripe strawberry and redcurrant flavours, supported by subtle notes of dried mixed herbs and wood smoke. A lighter medium weight red, with soft and pliant tannins. Easy drinking!
23. **Malbec, Beefsteak Club, Argentina** £20.00
Deep and vibrant Malbec with an intense nose of plum, damson and dark chocolate aromas. Lush and layered on the palate, with well-integrated oak and plenty of fine tannins.
24. **Côtes du Rhône, Remy Ferbras 2013, France** £22.00
Showing gorgeous, succulent notes of red and black berry fruit flavours and a warming hint of spiciness. Soft and supple tannins contribute to a long and rounded finish..
25. **Claret, Esprit de Lussac, Lussac St.Emilion AC, 2012, Bordeaux, France** £25.00
Beautiful garnet-red colour made from a blend of Cabernet and Merlot with aromas of cassis fruits coupled with subtle vanilla tones. A superb value wine but with real quality and pedigree.
